**Press Release**

Terrorist attacks on Mumbai in November 2008 were a barbaric act of wanton violence, not only against India but against all humanity. 158 Indians and 26 foreign nationals from 14 countries fell to terrorist bullets, and a large number of others were injured. Ms Jirachat Kanmanee, a Thai national and an employee of the Trident Oberoi Hotel, Mumbai, was killed in this dastardly attack.

2. Government of India had expressed deepest sorrow and condolences at the sad and untimely demise of Ms Kanmanee. The people of India share the grief of her family. As a token of expression of our solidarity, a sum of Baht Three Hundred and Fifty Thousand was extended in March 2009 to the next of kin, her sister Ms Omjit Kanmanee and family.

3. In memory of Ms Jirachat Kanmanee, an additional sum of Baht One Hundred and Forty Thousand on behalf of Prime Minister of India was handed over by Group Captain Umesh Kumar, Defence Adviser in the Embassy of India, Bangkok, to her sister on January 22, 2010 at Phuket.

4. On behalf of the Government, the people of India, and the Indian Embassy, Group Captain Kumar conveyed to the family of late Ms Kanmanee our heartfelt condolences once again and assured them of India's determination to make every effort to ensure that the perpetrators of this heinous crime against humanity are brought to justice.
